

WORKERS TOGETHER for jobs, salaries and the same rights for everyone



The USM-CGT and the CGT-Intérim defend the rights of all workers in the Chantiers Navals, whatever their status and wherever they come from

At the start of 2018, we are nearly 10,000 workers in the Saint-Nazaire Shipyards. The 15 ships to be built over the next 10 years guarantee a steady amount of work and the production of a lot of riches.

But working conditions continue to get worse: insufficient wages, widespread job insecurity, compulsory overtime (but not paid as overtime and sometimes not paid at all).

Together, we can defend ourselves and impose:

- decent living wages.
- all hours worked are to be monitored and paid in full.
- good working conditions, health and safety: tools, welding smoke, working space, noise, risk of falling, changing rooms, canteen....
- protection of union rights and freedoms: the same for all. All workers on the site have the right to be helped and represented by the union of their choice. The CGT welcomes and organizes all workers, no matter what their nationality or their status.

It's by uniting and fighting together that workers will be able to impose better working conditions, better wages and dignity for all.
